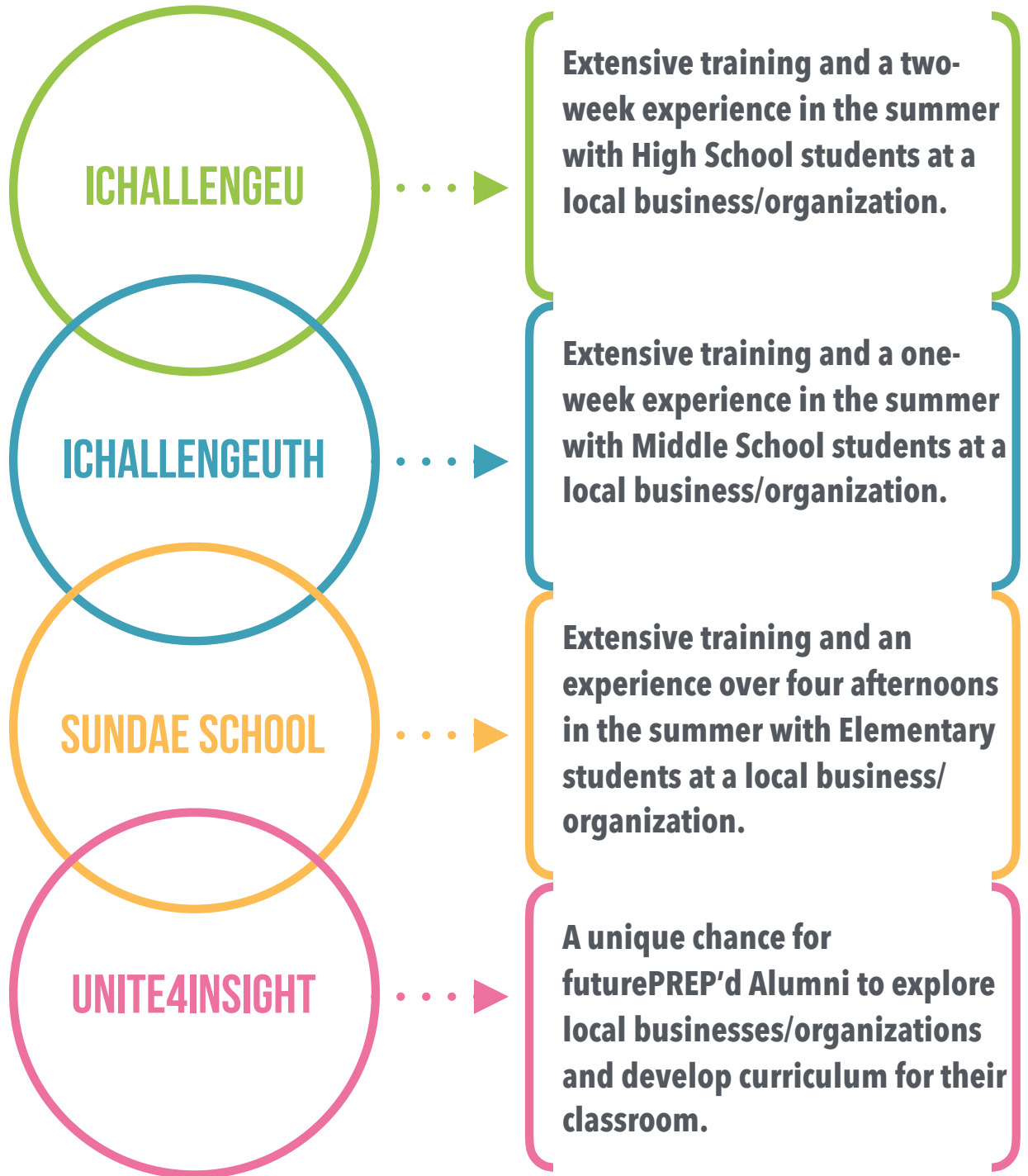

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Educators selected to be a part of the IChallengeU Program will be partnered with another master teacher from the Ottawa Area and a local industry/community partner and will go through a six day experience that will help prepare them for the two-week summer program. During the program in the summer, this team of teachers will facilitate the process of six - seven incoming juniors and seniors (1) exploring a real world issue that the partnering organization is facing and (2) developing and presenting solutions both to leadership at the partnering organization and a panel of judges on the last Thursday of the program. In addition, participating teachers will develop curriculum/units for their own classrooms based upon what they experience within the program.

SUNDAE SCHOOL IS A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY FOR K-5 EDUCATORS TO GUIDE A SMALL GROUP OF INCOMING 1ST - 5TH GRADE STUDENTS THROUGH THE PROCESS OF RESEARCHING, DEVELOPING, DECIDING UPON, AND COMMUNICATING A NEW ICE CREAM SUNDAE FOR A LOCAL ICE CREAM SCOOP SHOP.

Educators selected to be a part of the Sundae School Program will be partnered with another master teacher from the Ottawa Area and a local ice cream scoop shop and will go through a six day experience that will help prepare them for the four day, half-time program. During the program in the summer, this team of teachers will facilitate the process of six - eight incoming 1st - 5th grade students conducting research, developing possible sundae combinations, deciding upon which sundae could possibly work the best, and developing a way to "sell" the new sundae to potential customers. In addition, participating teachers will develop curriculum/units for their own classrooms based upon what they experience within the program.
